To begin the behind-the-wheel portion of the licensing process, you must first complete the classroom requirements. You must provide proof of completion, this would be in the form of a DEC-1 card issued to you by the classroom teacher. You must also provide your temporary permit issued to you by the Department of Motor Vehicles. At this time you may register with the school.

Upon registration the teacher will give the dates and times of the session. Once an agreement is made, the student is responsible for attending each date. Failure to do so could result in the student being rescheduled at a later date or expelled from the school. If this occurs no refund will be provided. Any student under 19 years of age is required by the Department of Motor Vehicles to complete 14 (50 minute) periods of in-car instruction. This includes 7 periods of behind-the-wheel and 7 hours of observation. The contract price for this service will be \$325 and may be paid the first day.

Should the Drive Right School not be able to perform its part of the contract in a reasonable time period a refund will be provided upon request.

The Drive Right Driving School WILL NOT make its vehicle available for students to obtain a driver's license from the Department of Motor Vehicles.

It is a requirement that students 18 years of age complete a state approved driver's education program prior to receiving a driver's license. Students 19 years of age and older may hold the learner's permit for 30 days in lieu of completing a driver training course.

The instruction provided in this school does not guarantee that any student will pass the state driver's license examination or that the student can secure a driver's license, or that the student will be guaranteed employment upon completion of this course.

Any session of in-vehicle instruction that is missed by a student will be made up on at the discretion of the instructor.

In the event that one-on-one instruction takes place the student must meet the observation requirements with at least one other student in the vehicle during in-vehicle instruction.

Drive Right Driving School is not responsible for students after the session is over. Please make arrangements to pick your child up promptly at the end of each session.
